CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated 05 July 2016.

Independent Auditors' Report

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying standalone financial results of **Integra Capital Limited** (formerly Integra Capital Management Limited) (hereinafter referred to as the 'Company') for the quarter and year ended 31st March 2025 (the 'standalone financial results'), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ('Listing Regulations') and SEBI Circular SEBI/HO/DDHS/DDHS/CIR/P/2019/115 dated 22nd October 2019.

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid standalone financial results:

- a. Are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations in this regard and SEBI Circular SEBI/HO/DDHS/DDHS/CIR/P/2019/115 dated 22nd October 2019; and
- b. Give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable Indian Accounting Standards, and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information for the quarter and year ended 31 March 2025.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing ('SAs') specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act'). Emphasis of Matter

We draw attention to exceptional item of Rs 30.00 lacs which represents services income that may or may not recur in future as is the nature of exceptional item. Our opinion is not modified in this respect.

The standalone financial results for the quarter and year ended 31st March 2025 have been prepared on the basis of the standalone annual financial statements.

The Company's Management and the Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of these standalone financial results that give a true and fair view of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Act and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations and SEBI Circular SEBI/HO/DDHS/DDHS/CIR/P/2019/115 dated 22nd October 2019. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the standalone financial results that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

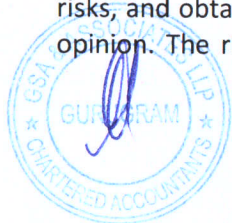
